Zlatan Plavac Barrique

A dry red wine made from selected Plavac Mali from the southern region of Hvar. Combined aging one year and a half in old and new barrique barrels, and another six months in the bottle after filling. The wine is rich in structure with a slight hint of meaty notes, aromas of prunes, cherries and chocolate. Distinctly southern character - a repeat medal winner.

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Zlatan Pošip

Pošip (po-ship) is a native Croatian white grape that only grows in southern Dalmatia. Full bodied with a golden yellow color, smooth and rich on the pallet, silky tannins and a dry finish with lovely minerality. Great with Mediterranean style food.

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Zlatan Plavac

Plavac Mali (pla-vatz ma-li) is the Croatian cousin to Zinfandel, grown on island Hvar. Full bodied, lean and dry, with aromas of rose petals followed by flavors of plums, cherries, and black pepper spice. Firm tannins and earthiness linger on the finish. Great with, red meats, roasts and game.
