

RUSSIAN RIVER CHARDONNAY

This Russian River Valley Chardonnay has a bright nose, with hints of soft lime and citrus flavors. Honeysuckle and apple add to the delightfully creamy combination of toasted almond and creme brulee. The result is a bright, fruit-forward wine with a very long finish.

RUSSIAN RIVER VALLEY PINOT NOIR

Pairs mature tannins with amazing ripe fruit flavors. Aromas of black cherry, blueberry, and toasted almond lead to a very fruit-forward wine highlighting ripe plum, cherry tobacco and mocha. Nicely integrated French Oak flavors add to the complexity.

SONOMA COUNTY CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Aromas of black currant, blackberry, and hints of cassis. Flavors of dried cranberry and black pepper are nicely integrated with the French and American oak. Mediumbodied and incredibly well balanced.

RUSSIAN RIVER SAUVIGNON BLANC

Refreshingly vibrant, with a fine mineral edge framing hints of pear and the perfume-like flavor of lychee. Grapefruit, key lime, and pomelo linger, while zesty acidity provides a firm framework.

CHARDONNAY 'GARAGISTE'

Like the renegade Bordeaux winemakers known as "Garagistes," Taft Street began in a garage rather than a grand chateau. This Chardonnay was 100% barrel fermented in Damy French oak, 15% was new, 45% 1-year old, with the remainder in 2-year and neutral french oak. aged nine months Sur Lie and 30% of the barrels underwent malolactic fermentation.

The wine's deep red/purple color accompanies distinct varietal notes of blackberry and cherry. Balanced acidity and intriguing oak undertones are parlayed into an elegant finish.
