



2019 CABERNET SAUVIGNON

Sonoma County

The Sonoma County Cabernet Sauvignon has aromas of black currant, blackberry, with hints of cassis. Flavors of dried cranberry and black pepper are nicely integrated with the French and Hungarian Oak. Medium bodied and incredibly well-balanced, this wine's silky long finish punctuates the quality of the Sonoma County fruit.

VINIFICATION & VINEYARD LOCATION

This Cabernet Sauvignon was aged for seven months on a combination of American and Hungarian Oak. The Cabernet was grown on the Vino Farms Dry Creek Valley vineyard north of the winery.

VINTAGE CONDITIONS

The 2019 season brought heavy rain to the Russian River Valley during the winter months, followed by cool temperatures and an extended growing season. This allowed the grapes to mature more gradually and ripen with slightly lower sugar levels, amazing flavor profiles and bright acidity.
