2017 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon

We take our Cabernet Sauvignon very seriously at Bravante Vineyards! Our distinct blocks provide multiple varietal characteristics which help build our final blend of Cabernet each vintage, as well as bringing the very important blending component for the addition of a small amount of Cabernet Franc and Petit Verdot.

The 2017 Estate Cabernet Sauvignon is deep ruby in color with ripe notes of blackberry and cassis balanced by secondary notes of violet, licorice and plum. On the palate soft tones of tobacco, near dark chocolate and coffee bean mingle with intense but integrated tannins, showing a beautiful structure balanced with a long finish. This structured and full bodied wine is quite complex and should age well for 10-12 years, or decant and drink now.
