Winemaking

The grapes are sorted as soon as they arrive at the winery, followed by traditional vinification with extraction and maceration in thermo-regulated stainless-steel vats with parcel selection.

Oak aging

Aged for 12 months in barrels (50% new, 50% one year old)

Château Lestage-Simon has a very complex nose, both fruity and spicy with aromas of red fruits and cherries. The palate is full, balanced and persistent with hints of blueberry jam and liquorice.
